## U-15 Participant Information and Age Definition

All current US Lacrosse members who meet the age requirements and have never played in high school play are encouraged to contact their local chapter regarding the U-15 National Youth Festival.

Players may not be 15 years of age on or before December 31, 2009 to be eligible for the 2010 US Lacrosse U-15 National Youth Festival. Accordingly, players that turn 15 after December 31, 2009 are eligible. Regardless of age, no player who has competed at the high school level is eligible to participate in the U-15 National Youth Festival. 9th GRADERS are not allowed to participate no matter what the situation.

**Reminder:** A player may only participate only once at this age level.
