



## Michael Breschi Scholarship Application August 15, 2012 Deadline

Scope: The Michael Breschi Scholarship is awarded to two graduating high school seniors who are the son or daughter of a coach and who has plans to attend college. The parents or guardian can be either a male or female coach in high school or college, and should be a full-time employee of an educational institution.

The scholarship winners are responsible for checking with the college or university to verify that his/her acceptance of this scholarship meets all institutional regulations, particularly with regard to financial aid packages. If the recipient is a scholarship-athlete, the scholarship must also meet all NCAA regulations as they pertain to that institution and the student-athlete.

The scholarship is a one-time scholarship of \$2,500 for each of two recipients. An amount of \$2,500 will be issued to the scholarship winner's college/university after the transcript of the first semester/quarter has been received by US Lacrosse.

- Two Letters of Recommendation:
  - One Letter of Recommendation from an academic instructor
  - One Letter of Recommendation from a mentor involved with community service

- In addition to being on the school's lacrosse team during the senior year, extracurricular activity, internships, community service, and employment experience are considered.
