ADMISSION & ATTRACTION TICKETS

All teams, including players and coaches, will have FREE admittance to all games with their participant credential. All players must register for their credential by completing the Disney Sports waiver form. Please bring completed waiver with you to the 2pm meeting on Tuesday, July 20 to exchange for your participant credential. [Click here to download Disney Sports Waiver.](#)

All other guests must pay for admission to the complex. A length of event admission is \$40.50/person for the entire three-day event, or \$13.50 per day. You must purchase your admission ticket at the front gate to the EWWOS Complex. Parking is free for all guests. *This is an ESPN Wide World of Sports policy.*

All other tickets to Disney theme parks and Orlando attractions can be purchased at the discretion of the athlete/family. US Lacrosse does NOT sell tickets. You will have to contact Disney or authorized dealer, such as Anthony Travel, directly.

ANNOUNCEMENTS


TRAINERS
