Fees for **out of season play** such as fall ball tournaments shall be \$1 of pay per 1 minute of umpiring per umpire. Pay for scrimmages shall be 60% of the above rates. Travel to be determined.

Ground Travel: Round trip mileage, set annually (42 cents per mile for 2006) including tolls if over \$10.00 when applicable.

Per Diem: \$35.00 per day of travel applicable when: umpires round trip ground mileage is 300 or more; when the game time necessitates umpires to stay overnight; OR when umpires are on extended road trips due to multiple assignments.

Accommodations: Lodging/hotel and parking fees provided when game time/travel necessitates an umpire to stay overnight.

Air Travel: When approved, the host institution shall arrange air travel directly with the umpires(s) involved and the umpire shall receive a \$100 air travel stipend. The host school shall provide ground transportation to and from the airport via school personnel or provide the official(s) with a rental car.

Cancellation Policy: In the event a game is cancelled the host institutions should notify the officials directly. The Athletic Administration/Coach shall contact the assignor for rescheduling. In the event a game is canceled after the officials have departed for the game, regardless if notified in route or after the officials have arrived at the site, the officials shall be paid half game fee, mileage and per diem if applicable. In the event a game is canceled at a point within 30 minutes of the scheduled start time, the officials shall be paid full game fee, mileage and per diem if applicable. In the event a game is canceled at a point after it has started, the officials shall be paid the full game fee, mileage and per diem if applicable.

Game Delays: In the event a game is delayed 1 hour beyond the scheduled start time: the umpires are not obligated to stay and shall be paid the full game fee, mileage, and per diem if applicable. If the umpires are willing to stay beyond the 1 hour, they shall be paid the full game fee, mileage, and per diem if applicable and a delayed game fee of \$15.00 per ½ hour or portion thereof.

In the event that teams have different start times for the game, the home team's start time is considered the "official game time".

Umpires who arrive past the pre-arranged umpire arrival time are subject to review by the college review board.
