



## 2014 World Championships FAQ's

- 1. Where can I find the link to the bid application on your website?**  
The bid application can be found on our website ([www.uslacrosse.org](http://www.uslacrosse.org)) under "Request for Proposals (RFP)" in the "Upcoming Events" section, which is located in the left-hand bar of our homepage. Please click on the "2014 World Championship Bids" where the application link can be found at the end of the proposal.
- 2. Can the Expo Area for the 50 booths be held on the concourse of our highlight facility or is a separate space needed?**  
The Expo Area must be accessible to fans visiting the Highlight/Championship facilities.
- 3. How much is the room rebate on the fan rooms?**  
The room rebate for the fan rooms is between \$5-\$10 and will offset the costs of the event.
- 4. Is it the host destination's financial responsibility to put the teams in dorm-like facilities or can the teams stay in a local hotel?**  
It is US Lacrosse's responsibility to provide an affordable housing and meal package, and in the past, dorm-like facilities have been appropriate. Each team is financially responsible for the team house and meal package.
- 5. How many administrative hotel rooms are needed (i.e. staff, media, etc.)?**  
100 administrative hotel rooms are needed.
- 6. Are meal arrangements for each of the 38 teams every day?**  
Yes, meal arrangements are required for each of the 38 teams every day.
- 7. Can the meals be held at the team's host hotel or does everyone need to be together for each meal?**  
Yes, however, it is preferred that they have a private team room where they can eat.
- 8. Do the teams cover their own expense or does this cost need to be worked into the event budget?**  
The teams cover their own expense.

**9. For the final banquet, is it the host destination's financial responsibility to stage this event?**

This is incorporated in the team meals and lodging fee paid by each team.

**10. What types of facilities are needed?**

Please refer back to the RFP.

**11. How many days is each of the fields in use?**

The Preliminary Round facilities will be needed for seven (7) days, the Highlight facility will be needed for nine (9) days, and the Championship will be needed the final two (2) days.

**12. Do the Preliminary Round facilities have to be within walking distance?**

It is preferred that the Preliminary Round facilities are within walking distance so that spectators can go from one game to the next. However, any Preliminary Round fields, within a reasonable distance, are accepted.
