

## Frequently Asked Questions and Answers

### **Q. HOW TO REGISTER FOR THE YOUTH FESTIVAL?**

- A.** The US Lacrosse Youth Festival is a US Lacrosse Chapter Event and you must go through the following steps to register a team:
1. Contact your US Lacrosse Chapter. Please visit the following webpage:

  2. US Lacrosse Chapter Presidents or Chapter Youth Festival Coordinators are the only people allowed to register teams.
    - a. If you are a Chapter President or a designated Youth Festival Coordinator for your Chapter you will be receiving application packets electronically and by February 19<sup>th</sup>, 2007.
      - i. If you have not received your packet by February 23, 2007, please contact the US Lacrosse Special Events department at [events@uslacrosse.org](mailto:events@uslacrosse.org).
    - b. Please contact your US Lacrosse Chapter to obtain US Lacrosse Chapter Team Nominations (*must contact USL Chapter for selection process*)
    - c. Please visit “*Connect with your Chapter*” on the US Lacrosse Website
- \*\*Individuals CANNOT register for this event; this is a Chapter registration only event. \*\***

### **Q. HOW MANY TEAMS CAN REGISTER PER CHAPTER?**

- A.** The US Lacrosse Youth Festival is a National event and therefore each Chapter can register (2) teams per chapter per Youth Festival: (1) Boy’s team and (1) Girl’s team.
- \*\* You can not send 2 boy’s teams or 2 girl’s teams, it has to be 1 boy’s team and 1 girl’s team \*\***

### **Q. WHAT IS THE COST OF REGISTRATION?**

- A.** Team Fees are listed below:
1. Registration Fee: \$300 (Deadline: March 23, 2007)
    - a. Must be turned in with a completed application
  2. Games Management Fee: \$1200 (Deadline: May 11, 2007)
- \*\*This DOES NOT include Travel or Housing fees\*\***

### **Q. WHAT ABOUT TRAVEL AND HOUSING?**

- A.**
1. **U-13 Youth Festival:** Travel arrangements will be made by the Chapter or the Chapter Youth Festival Coordinator. Teams will be staying on-campus at the University of Massachusetts. Housing payments will be collected by the Chapter from the athletes and one payment method (check, credit card) will then be submitted to US Lacrosse. Please do not send individual payments for housing.
    - a. **Housing Amenities Include:** A typical residence hall room is arranged for double occupancy providing each resident with a twin bed, dresser, desk and chair. Every room is equipped with a smoke detector. Residence halls are not air-conditioned. Public bathrooms are centrally located on each floor and rest rooms and public areas are cleaned daily, Monday through Friday. Coin-operated laundry is located in the same or an adjacent building. Linen service is provided and includes: 2 sheets, pillow with case, blanket, 2 towels, a bar of soap, and a plastic cup. Bathrooms will be cleaned on Saturday and Sunday.
  2. **U-15 Youth Festival:** All travel arrangements to be made through *Anthony Travel*. Refer to the Disney Handbook (located on the U-15 Youth Festival Website) for prices and contact information.

### **Q. DO I HAVE TO BE A US LACROSSE MEMBER?**
