I understand that I am committing to play in the 2007 US Women's Division National Tournament as part of my regional team by signing this application. In order to be considered for a spot, you must first submit the \$75 NO-SHOW fee to US Lacrosse. Once selected/notified, you will have a guaranteed spot in the tournament. Your spot is non-refundable, unless you have a season-ending injury and can supply documented medical proof of your injury or in the unfortunate event of a family death. US Lacrosse will not void the \$75 commitment "no-show" fee for players who are no-shows, as we are doing for all those players who do participate. In addition to the non-reimbursable fees, if you cancel or don't show, you will lose the right to stand for selection the following year.
