



Annual Nomination and Induction Process Timeline

December 15: To be eligible for consideration, all fully completed and signed Hall of Fame nomination questionnaires must be received at:

Note: All nomination questionnaires received after the December 15 deadline will not be eligible for induction within the current year, but will be automatically considered for induction the following year. Questionnaires can be submitted at any time through the year.

If a candidate is not selected for inclusion on the ballot within the year of initial nomination, they will remain eligible for consideration in subsequent years. It is not necessary to resubmit a new questionnaire annually, but submission of information regarding any new achievements, accolades or honors is highly recommended. All information will be reviewed annually and housed within the individuals' nominee folder at the National Lacrosse Hall of Fame.

January: National Lacrosse Hall of Fame men's and women's Ballot Committees form the annual men's and women's ballots containing the top-12 candidates for induction.

February: Ballots are released to the public and posted on US Lacrosse and National Lacrosse Hall of Fame websites.

March: National Lacrosse Hall of Fame voting process occurs.

April: Final candidates are submitted to the US Lacrosse Executive Committee for approval.

May: Annual class of men's and women's inductees is announced over Memorial Day weekend. Announcement will occur through press releases, US Lacrosse websites and print and broadcast media.

November: Annual National Lacrosse Hall of Fame Induction Celebration – event information can be found on the US Lacrosse website (www.uslacrosse.org).
