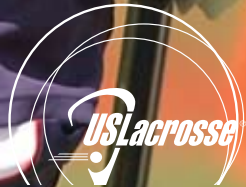


2006 U.S. Men's Team

The International Lacrosse Federation (ILF) World Championship began as a four-team invitational tournament that coincided with Canada's centennial lacrosse celebration in 1967. Seven years later, Australia celebrated its lacrosse centennial with a similar

international invitational tournament. It was here that the concept of holding a world championship tournament every four years was born. The U.S. has captured eight ILF World Championships and finished second in the ninth. Since an overtime loss in the 1978 championship, the U.S. has won 32 straight games.



The 2006 U.S. Men's Team was selected in June, 2005, after a four day tryout that included 120 of the nation's most outstanding players. The final

23-man roster was chosen by some of the country's most respected collegiate and post-collegiate coaches. The team will participate in the International Lacrosse Federation World Championship in London, Canada from July 13 to July 22, 2006. A record 18 nations will participate in the championship. The event will also feature a World Festival of Lacrosse for teams at various age levels.
