**To Potential 2010 U.S. Men's Senior Team Player:**

US Lacrosse is conducting a tryout to select the team that will represent the United States at the 2010 Federation of International Lacrosse World Championships in Manchester, England. The tryouts will take place starting with check-in on Sunday, June 7, 2009 through check-out on Wednesday, June 10, 2009 at Bryant University in Smithfield, RI (Providence).

Eighty players will be invited to try out. Applicants must adhere to the guidelines on the national team tryout website. Past members of U.S. Men's National Teams are required to submit an application to be considered for a tryout for the 2010 U.S. Men's Senior team.

The tryout camp is by invitation only. To be considered for a tryout invitation, you must submit an on-line application and pay the \$50 application fee **by Friday, January 30, 2009**. You must be a current member of US Lacrosse to be considered for a tryout invitation. Players who are not current members of US Lacrosse will be notified when they begin the on-line application and will be re-directed to renew/sign-up for a US Lacrosse membership.

The list of players invited to tryouts will be posted on the US Lacrosse website by mid-March. All applicants will be informed of their status via first class mail.
