



## **2003 ILF & IFWLA Under-19 Championship Policies**

Towson University, Towson, Maryland

June 26, 2003 through July 6, 2003

All participants (players, coaches and official team personnel) must adhere to the following event policies established by the ILF, IFWLA and/or Towson University or they will face disqualification from the event. Please remember that you are representing yourself, your team and your country at all times. All documented violations of these policies will be referred to the ILF and/or IFWLA Championship Committee for immediate review and penalty determination, including but not limited to event expulsion.

### **ILF & IFWLA**

- Each team member (players, coaches and support staff) will sign the Code of Conduct. All team members are required to be knowledgeable of the Code of Conduct.
- Evidence of date of birth of each member of each competing nation's team must be sent to the Championship Committee Secretary at least 60 days prior to the first game.
- Each residence hall will be a single sex residence hall. Members of the opposite sex, except for parents or guardians, are prohibited from entering the residence hall of the opposite sex at all times, unless they are a parent or guardian. Any athlete found in violation of this rule will be disqualified for the remainder of the event by the games committee of the ILF/IFWLA.
- Under-19 events are alcohol free. Alcohol may not be served or consumed at the venue. Athletes are prohibited from drinking during the event. Towson University prohibits the consumption of alcohol in the residence halls. Any player found in violation of this rule will be disqualified for the remainder of the event by the games committee of the ILF/IFWLA. Please note that it is illegal for anyone under age 21 to consume alcohol in the State of Maryland. Violators are subject to immediate arrest.
- The ILF and IFWLA abide by the International Olympic Committee (IOC) policies and procedures for illegal substance testing. As prescribed by these policies and procedures any positive test shall be referred to the Championship Committee for consideration, any athlete testing positive shall be ineligible to compete in any further games in the event, at least one athlete shall be randomly selected from each team to be tested in the Qualifying Round games, semi final and final games for each participating team.
- At no time are athletes to smoke a cigarette, cigar, pipe or other tobacco device while in uniform. It is strongly recommended that athletes abstain from smoking at all times as smoking has proven to be detrimental to your health and to the health of those around you.

### **Towson University**

- Towson University assumes no liability for bodily injury or personal property damage or loss. Doors to dorm rooms are to be locked at all times. Exterior doors are locked at all

times. The propping open or disabling the exterior doors is prohibited. Athletes are fully responsible for their actions. Please be considerate of others in and around your residence hall. Please note: Towson University does charge a replacement fee for lost keys and for damages to the rooms.

- Towson University and the Under-19 World Championships are drug free entities. Towson University fully supports the Federal and State laws regarding illegal drugs. Violations include but are not limited to, the following; drug use or possession of marijuana, heroin, LSD, cocaine, mushrooms, and ecstasy.
- Towson University prohibits smoking in the residence halls and in the stadium at all times.
- Towson University prohibits harassment of any kind.
- The use of athletic equipment in the residence halls is prohibited.
