Christian Zwickert, Head Men's Lacrosse Coach at Wesley College, son, Collin, was born on October 1, 2006. Up until the time of delivery Collin was 100% healthy. During delivery Collin became stuck and as a result suffered a severe brain injury. Shortly afterwards the doctors told Christian and his wife, Heather, that Collin would only live for 1 hour at best. After a brief time with parents, Collin was baptized and given his last rights and was taken to the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit where he stayed for 5 weeks. Since his birth, Collin has been diagnosed with Spastic Quadriplegic Cerebral Palsy, Reflux Disease, Dysphasia (can't swallow), Cortical Visual Impairment and Central Hearing Loss.

Collin receives over 32 in home therapies (speech, vision, occupational and physical) per month along with hospital trips for orthopedics, vision, neurology, ear/nose and throat to name a few. Collin receives over 10 daily medications and has had 20 surgeries, procedures and tests in the past 15 months.

Battling against tremendous odds Collin has enjoyed 2 Christmas' and his first birthday and is becoming healthier everyday. However, Collin's medical needs are ever growing. In addition, Coach Zwickert and his wife's needs for their son's care are growing as well. The purpose of this fundraiser is to help the Zwickerts raise money for experimental therapies not covered by insurance and to help raise money for a wheelchair adapted minivan.
