



Fall 2005 Coaches' Education Clinic Grant Program

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the Coaches' Education Clinic Grant?

For 2005-2006, US Lacrosse is awarding grants that will bring a free Coaches' Education Program Level 1 Instructional Clinic to qualified organizations and chapters.

What is included in the grant package?

The Clinic Grant provides for the travel, room, board, and compensation fees of trainer(s) conducting the clinic, registration fees for all participants (valued at \$50 per person), and clinic materials including workbooks and other materials for attendees. If an adequate site for the clinic is not able to be secured by the organization at no cost, the grant will also cover 50% of the site fee up to \$500.

What is the value of this grant?

The value of this grant is estimated at \$2,500-\$4,500 for each clinic awarded (combination grant value is higher).

May I apply for both a men's and a women's clinic?

Yes, it is encouraged that groups apply for a combination grant which includes both a men's game and a women's game clinic, provided they are held on the same day and the facility can support concurrent instruction (see Facility Guidelines).

Who will be conducting the clinic?

Only certified, trained Level 1 trainers will be sent to conduct the clinic. These trainers have gone through a rigorous screening process and extensive training in the curriculum in order ensure that only the best instruction is provided at the Level 1 Instructional Clinics.

Who may attend this clinic?

All coaches who attend must be current members of US Lacrosse and it is STRONGLY suggested that those who attend have completed the Level 1 Online course.

Will I have to register people for the clinic?

US Lacrosse will provide advance online registration for the clinic at www.uslacrosse.org. Hosts will be responsible for directing registrants to the website and for any walk-up registrations the day of the clinic.

How many people must come to the clinic?

It is recommended that a minimum of 25 coaches (50 for combination grant) pre-register online one week prior to the clinic. US Lacrosse reserves the right to cancel the clinic if inadequate interest is shown in registration numbers. It is the responsibility of hosts to promote the clinic and encourage participation.
