If your team does this, and your team provides their name and contact information on the application, US Lacrosse will reimburse your club team \$25 by the end of the spring season. Umpiring is a great opportunity for your team members, family and friends to learn more about the game of lacrosse and give back to the community, not to mention it is also well paying and flexible part time job for college students, usually \$50-100/game plus travel costs.
