

DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO NAVY-MARINE CORPS MEMORIAL STADIUM:

FROM BALTIMORE AND POINTS NORTH:

- From I-95 South, take the Baltimore Beltway East (I-695E),
- Take I-97 South 18 miles to US Routes 50E/301E.
- Take **LEFT** exit to US-50/301 East (toward Annapolis Bay Bridge) and go 2 miles to Exit #24, Rowe Blvd. South.
- Right turn at the second stop light onto Taylor Ave and follow the signs to a right turn into the **Blue-Side Parking Lot**.

FROM WASHINGTON AND POINTS SOUTH:

- Take the Washington Beltway, I-495/I-95, to Exit #19, US Route 50E.
- Take US-50 East (joins US-301) 35 miles to Exit #24, Rowe Blvd. South.
- Take Rowe Blvd. South.
- Right turn at the second stop light onto Taylor Ave and follow the signs to a right turn into the **Blue-Side Parking Lot**.

SHUTTLE INFORMATION:

Event Shuttle.

A limited shuttle service provided by US Lacrosse will transport fans directly to Glenn Warner Soccer Facility from Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium for the preliminary round games from June 23 - June 27. Shuttle will run one hour before the first game of the day and will continue until one hour after the final game of each day.

Navy Blue Shuttle provided by the city of Annapolis.

Runs on the hour and half-hour to and from Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium, Downtown, Gate 1 of the US Naval Academy. (See **Walking Directions**).

* Distance from Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium to Glenn Warner Soccer Facility = 1.8 Miles.

WALKING DIRECTIONS TO GLENN WARNER SOCCER FACILITY FROM GATE 1 AT THE US NAVAL ACADEMY:

- Must be prepared with a Photo ID
- Enter Gate One at intersection of King George Street and Randall Street.
- Turn left at Ricketts Hall onto Brownson Road
- Turn left at the stop sign onto Santee / Holloway Road
- Glenn Warner Soccer Facility will be on your right
- *Total distance from Gate 1 = .6 miles
