1	<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Current US Lacrosse membership with Official participation</p> <p>http://www.uslacrosse.org/membership/member-portal.aspx Join/Renew or sign in.</p>
2	<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Complete the Online Rules and Penalty Course</p> <p>https://learning.uslacrosse.org. Login with your USL username and password. Search for the rules course in the catalog.</p> <p>Upon completion you are emailed a certificate.</p>
3	<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Attend classroom training</p> <p>Your Certified Trainer will conduct the training for your area. Depending on where you live you may be scheduled into one class or several classes</p> <p>Contact your State Coordinator for information on upcoming trainings.</p>
4	<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Pass the Junior Official Field Evaluation</p> <p>No time limit. Should be completed as soon as possible after your classroom training. Local Certified Observer conducts the evaluation using the US Lacrosse Junior Official Evaluation Form.</p>
5	<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Pass either the USL/NFHS and Youth Girl's rules test with at least an 80% on the US Lacrosse Central Hub.</p> <p>Tests are available at https://uslacrosse.arbitersports.com/front/108525/Test.</p>
