



SELECTION PROCESS & CRITERIA FOR U.S. INTERNATIONAL ASSESSORS

CRITERIA

The criteria for an official to be eligible to apply as a candidate for the pool of assessors for a FIL International Championship event is listed below.

1. Be a current US Lacrosse member
2. Be a US Lacrosse Certified Observer and/or Certified Trainer
3. Have officiated and/or assessed at an FIL international championship event within the last twelve years
 - a. Ideal candidates will:
 - i. Be a US Lacrosse Certified Observer and/or Certified Trainer
 - ii. Have officiated the top division of an international event.
 - iii. Have served as an assessor at an international event.
 - iv. Have experience teaching and mentoring officials.

SELECTION PROCESS

The process for evaluating and ranking the candidate pool of officials for an FIL International event is below.

1. Application for eligible applicants to enter candidate pool for assessors must be completed for each specific event.
2. Pool candidates will be asked to pass:
 - a. FIL Rules Exam (closed book)
 - b. FIL Mechanics Exam (closed book)

Once all pool candidates have completed the selection process, the selection task force for an event will rank the candidates accordingly based on the data collected from the above process.

Candidates will not be notified of their ranking until after the FIL has requested assessors, the U.S. delegate to the FIL, has reviewed and advanced their names to the FIL and the FIL has accepted them for that event.
