



ADDITIONAL CLARIFICATIONS FOR THE 2018 USL/NFHS RULEBOOK UPDATED March 6TH, 2018

Rule 1 Art 2 Note:

Unified Field: recommend notifying opposing teams and officials prior to game.

Rule 2 Section & Personal Equipment

Art. 3 Close fitting gloves and headgear may be worn by all field players.

Clarification: All headgear must be properly worn and securely fixed with the chinstrap in place as intended for use.

Rule 5-2 Art 3. Draw Positioning:

b.

Note: The lower side of the crosse is defined as the right side of the crosse as the player looks at it with the open pocket facing her.

Rule 5-2 Art. 5 Player Positioning:

e. "Players may reach over the restraining line or center circle line and touch the ground with their stick to play the ball, as long as no part of the player's foot is on or over the line."

Clarification: If any part of the player's body is touching the ground on or over the restraining line whether her stick is touching the ground or not, she is in violation of player positioning.

e. "Players may reach over the restraining line or center circle line and touch the ground with their stick to play the ball, as long as no part of the player's foot is on or over the line."

Clarification: Stick can be touching the ground prior to/during the draw.

Rule 9 Art. 1:

d. Early Entry on the Draw:

Early Entry FP set up: **Closest opponent to the spot of the ball will be awarded the free position and the closest player on the offending team will go 4 meters away toward the goal she is defending. These players may be below the restraining line.**
